## Enhanced welfare facilities

The town government has been trying to enhance the welfare system so that everyone can live in peace and safety. Starting with the opening of “Kunneppu Seijuen”, in April 1990 “Honami”, “Haruru”, and “Mori no Kaze” were opened to make the town more people friendly.

### Retirement home “Kunneppu Seijuen”



The very first welfare facility in Kunneppu. There is a retirement home, short stay service, and day service.

### Nursing home “Honami”



This facility is for people who are 60 or older and have difficulties with family support.
